Township Successes in 2021

Projects Completed and Steps Forward in Other Projects

Your Township Supervisors are pleased to announce the completion of several projects in 2021.

Other projects are expected to be completed in 2022.

<u>COMPLETED:</u> Upper Salford Park to Perkiomen Trail Connector (P2P) The P2P Phase 1 from Upper Salford Park to Spring Mount Road is complete. The trail will be open to the public once all safety improvements are completed.

<u>STEPS FORWARD:</u> Phase 2 P2P Trail Connector – Construction from Spring Mount Road to the Perkiomen Trail will begin in January with a target completion date of May 2022.







COMPLETED: Spring Mount Adventures working with Upper Salford Township opened Spring Mount Ice, an ice-skating rink along side Spring Mountain Ski Area. The land under the slopes is preserved township open space, and Spring Mountain Adventures is charged an open space fee for each skier and skater.

COMPLETED: Disc Golf & STEPS FORWARD to NEW Playground Equipment – An Eagle Scout Project added 9 holes to the existing 9-hole Disc Golf Course. In 2021, the township solicited quotations for new upgraded playground equipment to be installed this summer as part of the Celebration of the 25th Anniversary of Upper Salford Park. Stay tuned for a celebration and ribbon-cutting ceremony for the P2P Trail and the new playground equipment.









2022 Budget-NO TAX Increase, AGAIN! *For the 18th consecutive year, Upper Salford Township Tax Rate has remained the same!* The fiscally prudent management of Upper Salford helps to keep our Township affordable to live in.

Township Septic Pumping Program (Every 3 Years Mandatory Pumping) It is your responsibility to pump your septic system once every 3 years to protect our well water. Property owners must provide a copy of the pumping receipt from the septic pumper to the Township office. 100% compliance is mandated. You can receive reminders to pump via email. Please help us to help you by giving us your email address. Please call the Township with any questions.

Snow Plowing and House Numbers During snowstorms do NOT park your car or place your trash cans on roads. Please help our Township Road Crew, who are operating the snowplows, so they can clear streets safely. In addition, we ask that you clearly display your house number in the event of an emergency to assist our first responders to arrive quickly at the correct destination.

Township Park Pavilion Reservations begin February 1st each year. Upper Salford Township is pleased to provide the opportunity to rent the pavilion at Upper Salford Park for your private event. Please note that bathroom facilities are only available from May 1st to September 30th. Reservations can be made on a first-come, first-reserved basis starting February 1st of each year. Please call the Township office for additional information, including rental rates and availability. NO consumption of alcohol is permitted in the park at any time.
