The August meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman Poatsy at 7:30 p.m. Messrs. O'Donnell and Sacks were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The Board shared several **public announcements**:

- The Board of Supervisors has been meeting with representatives from the EPA and Schwenksville Water Authority to discuss Baghurst remediation efforts. No meetings were held in July.
- The 2020 Census, which began on April 1st, is currently taking place. Please continue to complete the Census.
- The Perkiomen Valley Library has opened for curbside pick-up only due to COVID-19. More information can be found on their website. Construction has been completed.
- The Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy Annual Stream Clean-Up has been rescheduled for October 31st beginning at Rahmer Park.
- The 59th Annual Philadelphia Folk Festival will be held virtually August 13-16, 2020. Unfortunately, they will not be on-site for this year's Festival due to COVID-19.
- The Concert in the Park featuring Rollin' and Tumblin' was held on August 6th. Lower Frederick Township will host AM Radio Tribute Band on August 13th at the Upper Salford Park to allow for social distancing.
- The new township website is now live.

The following reports were presented for the month of July 2020: State Police, Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Plymouth Community Ambulance Association, Harleysville Area EMS, Zoning Officer, Building Inspector, Park Board, Road Superintendent, and Solicitor.

After the Road Superintendent report:

- Mr. O'Donnell reported that State has agreed to mill and pave Perkiomenville Road.
- Mr. O'Donnell reported that they met with the State about the traffic signal at Barndt Road and Route 63 and a list of action items was generated for the State to handle.

Mr. O' Donnell reported that the design phase for the **Park to Perkiomen Trail Connector** is nearing completion. Bids for construction will be prepared and advertisement will begin as soon the NPDES permit is obtained. The NPDES permit is in the final review phase and resubmission should be taking place in the next week.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of August in the amount of \$115,903.41 for payment.

The receipts for the month of August totaled \$69,950.53.

The Treasurer's report as of August 11, 2020 noted the following amounts: total assets, \$8,981,644.01; total liabilities, \$773,320.71; total equity, \$8,208,323.30. Total liabilities and equity equal \$8,981,644.01.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of the July 14, 2020 Board of Supervisors meeting, as submitted.
