PARADE INFORMATION:

- REGISTRATION and LINE UP: Line up at 9:30 on Potato Road. All are welcome to participate,
 whether it's in your antique vehicle, on a decorated tractor, float, or bicycle. You can even decorate
 yourself or your children and walk the short parade route. If you want to be considered for a prize at
 the end of the parade, please register at the table near the middle of Potato Road.

- VIEWING THE PARADE: We encourage everyone to watch the parade from anywhere along the
 parade route between Potato Road and the Firehouse. Please <u>plan ahead</u> and be careful with your
 parking.
- GATHERING AT THE FIREHOUSE: The parade will end at the Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company.
 Please plan to stay and gather with your friends and neighbors, enjoy a grilled hot dog, cake, and birch beer all complimentary (but donations are gladly accepted). Prizes will also be awarded.

IMPORTANT PARKING AND TRAFFIC INFORMATION

- POTATO ROAD TRAFFIC DIRECTION: As always, it is important that you respect the flow of traffic
 on Potato Road. Please approach Potato Road from Old Sumneytown Pike, NOT Old Skippack Road.
 NO EXCEPTIONS! Allow extra time to travel and drop off children, etc. if needed.
- PARKING AT THE FIREHOUSE: Parking at the firehouse for spectators will be limited. Please be
 considerate to those who cannot walk long distances and who need to park at the firehouse to view the
 parade. Instead, please consider parking in the parking lot of the warehouse at the top of Shelly Road
 and walk to the firehouse.
