May 14, 2024 Upper Salford, Pennsylvania

The May meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman Poatsy at 7:32 p.m. Messrs. O'Donnell and Sacks were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The Board of Supervisors shared **public announcements**:

- The Board of Supervisors has been in constant communication with representatives from the EPA on the continuing work on the Baghurst remediation efforts.
- The Summer Concert in the Park Series is as follows: June 6th will be The Left Edge Band, July 11th will be The Mighty Manatees, and August 1st will be All Worn Out. Concerts are free to the public and start at 7pm at Upper Salford Park.
- Perkiomen Valley Library is holding Stories in the Parks. They will be at Upper Salford Park on Thursday, July 18, 2024.
- The 61st Annual Philadelphia Folk Festival will be held on August 16, 17, & 18, 2024.
- A public thank you was expressed to the Folk Fest volunteers for their Clean-Up of the Park and the roads around the festival site on April 20th.
- There is a Zoning Hearing for 843 Spring Mount Road on May 21st at 6:30pm.
- The Township received a thank you letter from Perkiomen Valley Library. There are currently 777 cards issued for Upper Salford Township residents.

The following reports were presented for the month of April 2024: State Police, Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Special Fire Police, Plymouth Community Ambulance Association, Freedom Valley Medical Rescue, Zoning Officer/Building Inspector, Road Superintendent, Solicitor, Historical Society, Residential Pumping Receipt Update, and the Auditors' Report.

Public Comment:

• After the Historical Society report, Kurt Stein, Galen Lane, inquired if the name of Landis was spelled with an "i" or an "e".

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to assist at **Harleysville Country Fair Days** from May 24th-25th, if they so choose and have the volunteers available.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to assist with traffic and crowd control at the **Old Goshenhoppen Church** 147th Annual Oyster Picnic to be held on Saturday, September 7, 2024, rain date September 8, 2024.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to request assistance, should it be needed and to assist with the **Upper Salford Township Red, White, and Blue Parade** with traffic and crowd control on July 4, 2024, between 9am and 1pm.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to request outside assistance with traffic and crowd control on Thursday, August 15, 2024, during the arrival of campers for the **Philadelphia Folk Festival**, to request outside assistance with traffic and crowd control at the **Old Goshenhoppen Church** 147th Annual Oyster Picnic to be held on Saturday, September 7, 2024, with a rain date of September 8, 2024 from 11am to 6pm, and to request outside assistance with traffic and crowd control at the **WMGK Bonfire** to be held on Saturday, October 12, 2024, from 3:30pm to 10:30pm.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of May in the amount of \$92,708.56 for payment.

The receipts for the month of May totaled \$147,334.19.

The Treasurer's report as of May 14, 2024 noted the following amounts: total assets, \$11,029,486.59; total liabilities, \$233,671.59; total equity, \$10,795,815.00. Total liabilities and equity equal \$11,029,486.59.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of the April 9, 2024 Board of Supervisors meeting, as submitted.

Public Comment:

• Mr. Poatsy shared that he was in Washington, DC last week as a representative of Upper Salford Township and PSATS.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the meeting adjourned at 8:18 p.m.
