

April 14, 2026  
Upper Salford, Pennsylvania

The April meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman Poatsy at 7:33 p.m. Messrs. O'Donnell and Sacks were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The Board of Supervisors shared **public announcements**:

- The Agriculture Security Area Advisory Committee met prior to tonight's meeting to address an administrative matter. No actions taken.
- The Board of Supervisors has been in constant communication with representatives from the EPA on the continuing work on the Baghurst remediation efforts.
- Volunteers are needed to help plan the America250PA event in Upper Salford Park on October 10, 2026.
- The Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy held their Annual Stream Clean-Up Day on Saturday, April 11<sup>th</sup>. One of the sites included the area around Rahmer Park.
- The Philadelphia Folk Fest crew (Groundz) will hold their Annual Clean-Up Day on Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup> starting at 9am at Upper Salford Park. All are welcome to join in.
- The Souderton-Telford Professional & Business Women's Group will be holding their annual Locally Grown Showcase at Upper Salford Park on Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10am to 3pm. The event will be held rain or shine.
- The Summer Concerts in the Park Series are as follows: June 4<sup>th</sup> will be Bob T & The T-Bones, July 2<sup>nd</sup> will be The Mighty Manatees, and August 6<sup>th</sup> will be Mike Guldin and Rollin' & Tumblin'. Concerts are free to the public and start at 7pm at Upper Salford Park. Maureen Stacy was acknowledged for her generosity for sponsoring the bands in memory of her late husband, Jack.
- Local resident, Terry Smith, will be appearing on Wheel of Fortune, on Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup> at 7pm on Channel 6ABC.

The following **reports** were presented for the month of **March 2026**: State Police, Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Special Fire Police, Plymouth Community Ambulance Association, Freedom Valley Medical Rescue, Planning Commission (Joint Meeting), Zoning Officer/Building Inspector, Road Superintendent, Solicitor, Historical Society, Residential Pumping Receipt Update, and Indian Valley Regional Planning Commission.

**On a motion** made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved **Resolution #2026-3: Recognition of Andrew Braunfeld**, for his many years of service to the Upper Salford Township and the Philadelphia Folk Festival. Mr. Braunfeld was presented with a signed copy of the Resolution.

**Leah Callahan, a Life Scout from Troop 229G**, delivered a presentation about her Eagle Scout project. She outlined her plans to improve the entrance of Upper Salford Park by planting a variety of low maintenance, colorful plants that will bloom year-round. **On a motion** made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the **Eagle Scout project** to improve the entrance to Upper Salford Park.

**On a motion** made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved **Resolution #2026-4: Pennsylvania Safe Digging Month**, recognizing the month of **April 2026** as **Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month**, on behalf of the PA One Call System.

**On a motion** made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved **Resolution #2026-5 Authorizing the Destruction of Specific Records - Schedule Exhibit "A"**.

**On a motion** made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to assist at **Montgomery County Heroes Festival** on May 16<sup>th</sup>, if they so choose and have the volunteers available.

The discussion regarding the **Agricultural Security Area request** has been **tabled** for subsequent review and future consideration. It was recommended that a Township Supervisor contact the County Farm Board to address outstanding questions and concerns.

**On a motion** made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of April in the amount of \$282,207.45 for payment.

The receipts for the month of April totaled \$466,376.32.

The Treasurer's report as of April 14, 2026 noted the following amounts: total assets, \$11,700,133.30; total liabilities, \$332,500.19; total equity, \$11,367,633.11. Total liabilities and equity equal \$11,700,133.30.

**On a motion** made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of the March 10, 2026 Board of Supervisors meeting, as submitted.

**Public Comment:**

- Mr. Poatsy shared that the Patriotic Order Sons of America donated 80 American Flags (40 – 13 star and 40 – 50 star).

**On a motion** made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
