The August meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman Poatsy at 7:30 p.m. Messrs. O'Donnell and Sacks were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The Board of Supervisors shared **public announcements**:

- The Board of Supervisors has been in constant communication with representatives from the EPA on the continuing work on the Baghurst remediation efforts.
- Volunteers are needed to help plan the America250PA event in Upper Salford Park on October 10, 2026. There will be Trolley Rides and Fireworks.
- The final Concert in the Park was held on August 6th and featured Mike Guldin and Rollin' & Tumblin'. Thank you again to Maureen Stacy for generously sponsoring and scheduling the concerts in memory of her husband, Jack. Thank you to Tabor Church for providing snacks and water.
- There was a Zoning Hearing held on Monday, August 10th for a Special Exception at 1620 Sumneytown Pike, for the placement of a fence.
- The 63rd Philadelphia Folk Festival will be held from August 14th to August 16th.
- USVFC will be holding their 9/11 Remembrance Walk at Upper Salford Park on Friday, September 11th at 6pm. It is open to all. This is the 25th anniversary of 9/11.
- USVFC Ladies Auxiliary will be holding their Penny Auction on September 19th at 6:30pm. Doors open at 5:30pm. Donation is still \$1.00.
- The 1st Annual Charity Disc Golf Tournament is being held on September 26th with check-in beginning at 8:30am, to benefit the USVFC.

The following **reports** were presented for the month of **July 2026**: State Police, Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Special Fire Police, Plymouth Community Ambulance Association, Freedom Valley Medical Rescue, Zoning Officer/Building Inspector, Road Superintendent, Solicitor, Historical Society, Indian Valley Regional Planning Commission, and Residential Pumping Receipt Update.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized **Resolution #2026-6**, designating temporary no-parking areas and tow away zones and regulating traffic, and public access to Upper Salford Township parklands, during the **2026 Philadelphia Folk Festival**.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of August in the amount of \$124,758.89 for payment.

The receipts for the month of August totaled \$76,002.33.

The Treasurer's report as of August 11, 2026, noted the following amounts: total assets, \$11,996,969.40; total liabilities \$323,994.94; total equity \$11,672,974.46. Total liabilities and equity equal \$11,996,969.40.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of July 14, 2026 Board of Supervisors meeting, as submitted.

- *Mr. O'Donnell announced that Hear Again America will open in the Shelly Square Shopping Center, with a grand opening scheduled for Monday, August 17, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.*
